

## **Pacific Crest Trail Hike** July 29-August 3, 2024

Dear Swedish Falls patrons, It has been a delight to meet many of you this summer at the Koroneberg Festival or our Corona Tearoom. For those of you that came from Scandinavia, sourcing products you remember from your homeland has helped us greatly expand our selection of herbal teas, berries, canned fish, and other delicacies from the Nordic forests and seas. Inspired by the stories we heard of foraging for Lingonberries and Cloudberries, and making new Swedish recipes with those we imported, my son and I will attempt a long planned 40 mile hike on the Pacific Crest Trail to finish out our summer.

We will be taking along a variety of Swedish Falls products for sustenance, including our Rosenmuller cookies with Nordic berries, trail mix, herbal teas, canned fish, as well as some new mushroom cocoa mixes and dried vegetable soup mixes. Each food is chosen to give us the most complete nutrition per pound and some great flavors to enjoy on our 5 day hike from Anza to the peak of Mount Jacinto, and back down to Idylwild.

Our energetic dog Bea will be joining us on the hike as well. She has been training with us all summer and will take rattlesnake training in Idyllwild to keep herself and us safe from snakes on the trail. We have been researching other potential hazards along our planned route and emergency escape routes. We will document whether the water sources others have found on the route are still flowing in August and carry enough water for several days of hydration if they are dry. We are also packing a solar water heater to sterilize the water and make soups, hot cocoa, and tea along the way.



We hope to invite some of you to join us on future hikes as well, on this section of this Pacific Crest Trail or other routes any of you might recommend. While I will resume teaching High School Biology, Chemistry, and Environmental Science this fall

we hope to see many of you in our Corona tearoom on Saturdays or at one of the events we plan to be vendors again in this fall. Right now, we plan to join the Viking Festival in Vista September 21-22, The SWEA Christmas Fair in Huntington Beach, and the SWEA Christmas Fair in Santa Monica December 2.
